Individual A
\$3,560.00 An Individual Member shall have unlimited Golf Privileges and access all GCC facilities. An individual's spouse (or domestic partner) and dependent children may golf under guest rules and rates and will have use of GCC facilities as defined in the Membership Levels.

Family AB
\$4,275.00 At the beginning of each calendar year, a family shall designate one "A" Member and one "B" member. The "A" Member shall have unlimited golf privileges. The "B" member and dependent children under the age of 26 shall have golf privileges with restrictions as defined in the Membership Levels. All family members will have access and use of club facilities.

Social
\$1,500.00 Unlimited use of clubhouse facilities and invitations to all social events. Access to the club's beach. Golf privileges include four (4) rounds of golf per month, with green fees waived for one (1) round, while the remaining three (3) require payment of green fees. Cart fees, if applicable, must also be paid, and members have unlimited access to the driving range and putting green. If a tournament is not fully booked, the Golf Committee will notify social members via email two (2) days prior, inviting them to participate, though members cannot act as substitutes in any league. Guest privileges allow members to bring guests for dining, social events, or golf at guest rates. Valid anytime during the week or after 10:30 on Weekends.

Junior Executive
\$1,985.00* A Junior Executive Membership shall be available to any individual between 18 and 35 years of age. At the age of 33, a Junior Executive's annual membership fee will increase yearly as shown. Any person at the age of 36 as of January 1 for the calendar year must become a full member. A Junior Executive Member shall have unlimited Golf Privileges. A Junior Executive's spouse (or domestic partner) and children will be allowed access to the beach and may golf under guest rules and rates. Loan and Capital Improvement Assessments and monthly food minimums are waived for the Junior Executive Levels. The total number of Junior Executives shall be limited to 20.

Junior Membership
\$630.00 A Junior Membership shall be available to an individual twelve (12) to eighteen (18) years of age. A junior Member shall have limited golf privileges and use of golf facilities with restrictions as defined in the Membership Levels.

Beach and Dining
\$1,135.00 A Beach and Dining Member and dependent family members shall have unlimited access to the beach and grove area. Extended family members and guests are permitted and subject to guest fees. The primary B&D Member may play golf once per month. Guest fees will apply. A B&D Member may not bring guest for golf. A B&D Member shall be allowed to play as a guest of a golfing member. A maximum of 24 Beach & Dining Members shall be allowed.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Codes of Conduct have been developed to ensure a safe, friendly, and respectful place for members, visitors, staff and the Board to gather in the spirit of cooperation, relaxation, good will, fun and friendly competition. The Code of Conduct differs from rules in that it addresses acceptable/unacceptable behavior.

All members & visitors are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that:

- Creates an environment and culture that is reflective of the personal integrity and respect taught in the rules of golf where it is written and that we are capable of enforcing rules upon ourselves with honesty, integrity, and good sportsmanship. This same integrity, honesty and good will are expected whether on the golf course, at the beach, grove area, boat docks or while boating or fishing.
- Acknowledges GCC as a family friendly environment and, therefore, refrains from using obscenities and loud boisterous behavior inappropriate for children and good taste.
- Observes proper etiquette on and off the course, in and around the lake and club house.
- Is reflective of being an Ambassador for Glocester Country Club (GCC) when out in the community, at other clubs and/or at GCC. We are all representatives of Glocester Country Club.
- Shows the utmost respect and dignity to fellow members, staff, and visitors.
- Does not damage the character, integrity, good will, property, and community view (local and/or the broader community) of GCC and/or staff.
- Is reflective of an adherence to ALL club rules:
 - Sign in procedures in the Pro Shop.
 - Rental and safe operation of carts in designated areas ONLY.
 - Obeying guidelines concerning the areas on which carts are not allowed off the cart paths.
 - Seeking Pro's approval for starting a hole other than number 1.
 - Obeying signs "Open or Closed" for the driving range unless proper permission is sought and received from pro shop staff.
 - Use and proper care of putting green.
 - Use of beach and obeying lifeguard direction.
 - Pride in the physical appearance of GCC as it is reflective of our membership.
 - Demonstrate an understanding that members and visitors have no authority to instruct staff in job performance and duties.
 - Understand that the Golf Professional, Greens Superintendent and Kitchen manager is responsible for instructing the staff in the performance of their duties.
 - Is vigilant in reporting real or perceived safety hazards to staff and/or Board of Governors.
 - Understand that the membership through the Board may make suggestions regarding the operation of the club.
 - Does not denigrate, talk down to, scream at staff members, general membership and/or guests and does not create unnecessary strife and divisiveness.
